To all ENW supporters,

As some of you know, we have been praying for the opportunity to minister stateside as well as internationally. God has wonderfully answered that prayer. You may remember one of the men, Mike Faidley, I've had the opportunity of mentoring for the last 12-14 years is leading a church plant in Somerset, Pennsylvania. I just returned from Pa. where we are continuing to help with the development of Grace Bible Fellowship. This body of believers was chartered in June of 2013 with about 50 members. It was a huge honor to be there for this service along with the elders from Faithway Baptist Church in Greensboro, North Carolina. Grace is a daughter church of Faithway. God is adding to the church and Grace now has about 70 members now with approximately 110-120 coming each week for Sunday services. Their Wednesday night services average about 65.

One of the components of this ministry is Grace Shepherds Institute. This "in-house" training program exists for the primary purpose of equipping shepherds for leadership in Grace and, if God wills, area church plants in the future. There are two men being evaluated and trained now. If the training moves along as planned, Grace will ordain at least two more pastors this fall. It was encouraging to be part of the first official training sessions of GSI during this trip. II Timothy 2:2 is the pattern given to the church for developing "next generation" shepherds. By the grace of and to the glory of God we want to embrace that responsibility and privilege with enthusiasm. There will be continuing training sessions throughout this year...ENW looks forward with anticipation to being involved in them.

Below are a couple of pics of the men we are equipping. There are some men attending the training sessions who just want to learn but have no "I Timothy 3:1 desire"...we welcome them and praise the Lord for the opportunity to influence family leaders and potential deacons. Also it is encouraging to have a father/son attending. The son has some ministry interest so he attends with the support of his dad. At this point we're just not sure where that interest may lead but Grace takes recognition and evaluation of desires and giftedness seriously. The opportunity to build a pastoral development, training and ministry model for young men is vital. These are growing, challenging and exciting times for the congregation of Grace...and for the opportunity of ENW to be part of this in the early developmental stages of Grace Bible Fellowship and Grace Shepherds Institute.
