This is the first time *Arabic* has been the national language. And, as usual, all the student notes were translated into the national language. This was an 80-hour project. How do I know, you may ask...I spoke to the church staff member who did it...many thanks to pastor Fadi for this investment of time & labor of love for the pastors. He also served as one of our translators during the teaching sessions.



Reymond, the national pastor we coordinated with, made sure everything was as it should be for the

conference to run smoothly. He had requested that we bring, for our first visit, the training in Biblical Counseling. We were happy to do this. And I am glad to say all the attendees received it very well. We were able to lay an initial foundation for counseling but there is still much that needs to be done in order to establish this firmly.

Jack Lezza, an assistant pastor at Independent Baptist Church in Boiling Brook, Illinois, was my traveling companion and teaching partner. It was an honor to have him along. He certainly has a heart for ministry and specifically for equipping and training. He was just the right man for this assignment.

I also want to *publically* thank Independent Baptist Church, led by Dave Shoaf, for making this trip possible by their generosity. IBC has helped with ENW trips in the past for which we are humbled and grateful.

The ministry of ENW continues this fall with 2-3 mission conferences, some weekend ministry opportunities (including a trip out west—Wyoming) and our annual tour to the Philippines in October. We are also in the process of developing Units 9-11 that will be made up of doctrinal themes and advanced counseling topics.

This will be ENW's 8th year to these wonderful Pilipino folks. We will be teaching at our two main training bases but we'll also be pioneering in a new area...on another island, which we will travel to by boat. This will be a first. This adds a bit of excitement as we anticipate being there again. Of course, your prayers are greatly appreciated for all these upcoming opportunities.
